

RUSSIA 1917

Russia entered the war with the largest army mobilized of any combatant. However, more than two years of constant, bitter fighting and disastrous losses had taken their toll on men and material. By the end of the Brusilov Offensive, the average *frontovik* had grown disillusioned by the war and the government leading it.

The Provisional Government that came to power after the Tsar's abdication pledged to fight a war of self-defense against the Central Powers to appease the war-weary public. However, France and Britain's insistence on continued pressure from their Russian allies saw the newly minted Revolutionary Army launch a final, desperate offensive.

47MM LIKHONIN MORTAR

Up to three of these may be selected and group together as a single mortar section on or off-table, activating on a Command Dice roll of 2. Individual mortars will activate as a Team on a roll of 1.

58MM FRANCO-RUSSIAN MORTAR

Up to three of these may be selected and group together, off-table, as a single mortar section, activating on a Command Dice roll of 2. Individual mortars will activate as a Team on a roll of 1.

PORUCHIK

A Poruchik can be selected as a replacement for an Inferior Senior Leader in a Frontovikov Platoon, or as a second Senior Leader in other platoons. Only one Poruchik can ever be selected.

RUSSIAN NATIONAL CHARACTERISTICS

MUZHIKI

Long accustomed to hardship, the enlisted peasants who made up much of the lower ranks exhibited their characteristic tenacity even amidst the environments of the Great War.

To represent this, Russian infantry add one to each D6 of movement when crossing Heavy Going or Really Heavy Terrain.

OKHOTNIKI

The Russian Army's regimental scouting detachments were recognized by both friend and foe alike for proficiency in combat and infiltration.

As such, Razvedchikov Sections can move Normally using 2D6 and assume a Tactical stance at the end of their movement.
